Abraham Lincoln wrote and spoke the famous words known as the Gettysburg Address (below) at the ceremony on November 19, 1863 He was not the main speaker for the dedication Edward Everett, a well-known orator, was the chief speaker and spoke for two hours Lincoln's speech consisted of 272 words, lasted 2 minutes, and became known as
