Hans Christian Andersen, 1805-1875 Hans Christian Andersen was born in humble surroundings in Odense, Denmark, on 2 April, 1805, the son of a shoemaker and a washerwoman His father loved literature and encouraged young Hans to write tales and put on puppet shows However, he died when Hans was just 11, which meant that the boy was sent out
